
How Many?

1840s	Arrival of thousands of Irish settlers	 Irish potato crop fails; facing starvation, many Irish move to Canada and other countries
1905-1914	 Massive immigration to Canadian west from eastern Europe 	 Canadian government, wanting to settle the Prairies, offers free land and other incentives to immigrants
1915-1919	Little immigration	 World War I and worldwide influenza epidemic limit immigration
1930-1945	Little immigration	 World-wide economic depression and World War II limit immigration
1956	 Many Hungarians come to Canada 	 Hungarians revolt against the Russians fails; refugees come to Canada to avoid punishment
1980s-1997	 Arrival of thousands of Hong Kong Chinese 	 Immigrants are looking for political stability before China takes control of Hong Kong in 1997
