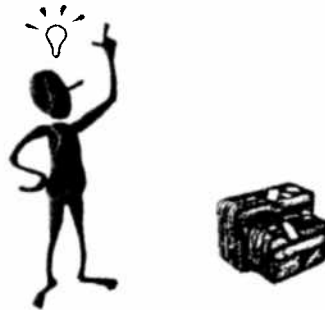
\* *Margaret Chalice*, a computer service representative for a transnational company, has travelled 125 km for an annual visit with a customer and will return home the same day.
