You will be creating a display board that will include all of the information below. All of your written work must be in **YOUR WORDS**. And must be in **complete sentences**, not point form. If you cut and paste information from the Internet, you will earn a grade of zero (that is plagiarism)

- COUNTRY OVERVIEW (2 paragraphs)
 - Name of the country
 - Geographic location and capital city
 - Population
 - Physical geography (landforms, climate etc...)
 - Two (2) reasons why you chose this country for your project

- POPULATION STATISTICS (Chart + 1 paragraph)
 - Find the following population statistics using the Atlas or CIA World Factbook (google these) for **both your country AND Canada** and compare them in them in the chart provided: Total Population, Population Density, Birth Rate, Death Rate, Literacy Rate, Life Expectancy, GDP per capita, and Ethnic Composition.
 - Write one paragraph that compares the population statistics of your country and Canada. Ask yourself questions like: What statistics are similar? Different? What patterns do you notice? Why might these patterns exist?

- Describe the traditional dress or costumes of the country and explain their meaning

- 2) **Display Board and Short Presentation:** You will be responsible for creating a **display board** to present your work about the country that you researched. Along with visuals you must have **one cultural artefact** (e.g. costume, bringing in a food or beverage, music, souvenir, or other cultural artefact) with you on the day of the festival. You will provide a brief 3-5 minute overview about the country you studied.

Display Board Instructions:

1. Include a clear **title** on your display board. Make it catchy so people want to read more about it!
2. Neatly paste your report (including charts) onto the display board.
3. Create a **Political Map** of the country. You can use a blank outline map of the country from the Internet but you cannot simply paste a map that has already been created. **You must follow all of the mapping rules and:**
 - locate and label the **capital city** of the country
 - **3 other major cities**
 - **3 significant bodies of water.**
4. **Country Flag.** Draw ~~an~~ an image of the country's flag and place it on your board.
5. Include a wide range of **visuals** (images, drawings, magazine cut outs, paintings) to illustrate different aspects of the country's physical and human geography. You should have a **minimum of 8 visuals** on your board.
